

Habitat for Humanity



The Social Action committee has participated in building and fundraising for the San Gabriel Valley Habitat for Humanity for a number of years.

SGV Habitat has completed 37 affordable homes in Glendale and has served the community for 26 years by building and repairing affordable homes for low-income families.

In February 2016 they were meeting with prospective buyers, low-income, first-time homebuyers, currently living in crowded or substandard housing conditions who are willing to contribute a minimum of 500 hours of Sweat Equity in building their home and the homes of their future neighbors. This will be the ninth partnership build with the Housing Authority of the City of Glendale.

Cash must be raised and gifts-in-kind of building materials and pro bono services must be secured so that six more deserving, low-income families who live and/or work in Glendale will achieve the dream of homeownership.
